## CALL FOR PROPOSALS FOR THE

# P-22 Memorial Sculpture

P-22'S MIRACULOUS JOURNEY ACROSS TWO OF LOS ANGELES' BUSIEST FREEWAYS AND HIS INCREDIBLE STORY OF SURVIVAL AGAINST ALL ODDS CAPTURED THE IMAGINATION OF ANGELENOS — AND PEOPLE FROM ALL OVER THE WORLD. HE INSPIRED A NEW ETHIC OF COEXISTENCE, AND HIS PLIGHT LED TO THE SUPPORT FOR THE BUILDING OF THE WALLIS ANNEBERG WILDLIFE CROSSING.

## PROPOSALS MUST INCLUDE:

- Name and contact information of artist
- Biography and statement of qualifications
- Statement outlining artist's connection to P-22
- Estimated cost—estimated cost not to exceed \$100,000, preference for less. Please provide breakdown:
  - Artist fee
  - Fabrication cost estimate
  - Installation cost estimate
- Estimated timelines to create, fabricate and install
- Whether fabrication or installation is provided by artist or other party/parties

## PROPOSALS MUST ALSO COMPLY WITH THESE PARAMETERS:

- Sculpture must represent a reasonable likeness of P-22 or P-22's face (no abstractions)
- Sculpture size must fit the site, physically and aesthetically
- Must be fabricated to withstand the weather given the outside setting
- Must be durable and damage resistant to extent possible
- Must address safety concerns for sculptures, given public access
- Sculpture must minimize vulnerability to theft and defacing in its design and installation
- No wood or other highly flammable materials

**Submission deadline for initial qualification is January 31, 2025**  
**Installation target date is P-22 Day, 2025, if possible**
